## DUMPING GARBAGE IS A CRIME

It is **illegal**, according to the Public Health Law and the Litter Law, to dispose of garbage by throwing it on public or private property, such as deserted or open lots.

A **CI \$ 500** fine can be issued under the Litter Law and

a **CI \$ 1,000** fine can be issued under the Public Health Law..

## THERE IS AN **EASIER WAY**

Deposal of waste is free at the landfill. Why break the law and hurt our environment when doing the right thing is just as easy?

**Free of charge.** All landfills in the Cayman Islands accepts all types of waste free of charge. This includes household appliances, all metal items, used motor oil, and other hazardous waste.

**24 Hour Drop Off Area** located at the entrance of the George Town Landfill. It is open to the public for disposal of bulk waste, vegetable waste and household appliances.
