### POSTER COMPETITION

- One entry per student. All entries must be accompanied by an entry form.

- Posters must include elements found in the Cayman environment.

### ESSAY COMPETITION

- Students ages 6-11 years old may either submit hand written entries or typed double spaced entries. Maximum length of essay is 5 pages.
- Students ages 12-16 years old should be typed double spaced and the maximum length is 8 pages.

- Essay should include references to the Cayman Islands.
